**Most higher ed
teams run
4–6 versions of
the same

AI can't handle that level of variability

Before you add automations, ask:

1. Is the workflow documented?
2. Is it consistent?
3. Is it repeatable?

If not, you're not ready for automation.

A simple workflow redesign can cut:

- 20–40% manual steps
- 10+ hours/week in data entry
- 50% of handoff errors

only gets you into trouble faster.




If you fix the workflow first, AI becomes simple:
