The AI Readiness Paradox



L&D leaders are investing in:

- AI tool subscriptions
- Training programs
- Pilot projects

But still seeing minimal adoption.

The issue? Four critical gaps are silently sabotaging your efforts—and most teams only address one or two.


The 4-Gap Framework for AI Readiness



Successful AI adoption requires closing ALL four gaps simultaneously:

- 1) Capability Gap** – Do your people have the skills?
- 2) Data & Infrastructure Gap** – Can your systems support AI?
- 3) Governance Gap** – Do you have policies and oversight?
- 4) Human/Affective Gap** – Are your teams ready and willing?

Think of them as four legs of a table.
If one breaks, everything falls.





Which Gap Is Holding You Back?

Capability Gap (40% of teams) — Staff lack AI literacy and design skills


Data Gap (35% of teams) — Poor data quality and siloed systems

Governance Gap (15% of teams) — Missing policies create paralysis

Human Gap (10% of teams) — Resistance and fear block adoption


Most teams don't know which gap is their bottleneck.

What Happens When You Skip Steps?

- 
- ✗ Buy AI tools before fixing data → Disappointing results, wasted budget
 - ✗ Train staff without governance → Teams not learning new tools or following processes
 - ✗ Focus only on capability → Infrastructure can't support scale
 - ✗ Ignore the human element → Silent resistance kills momentum

The sequence matters as much as the solution.

A Strategic Approach to AI Readiness



- ✓ Diagnose first – Identify your weakest gaps
- ✓ Sequence strategically – Address governance and data before scaling
- ✓ Build in parallel – Develop capability while fixing infrastructure
- ✓ Never ignore humans – Change management isn't optional

Real readiness = balanced progress across all four gaps.
